

United Methodist Minister's Family Tuition Award Application

Minister's Family Awards for full-time study are given to the dependent child or spouse of a United Methodist Minister, who is ordained, under appointment, retired or deceased. Participants must meet all of the standard requirements for admission to the University and must maintain a 2.000 overall cumulative grade point average in order to maintain eligibility. Participating students must be candidates for a baccalaureate degree or a graduate degree (students enrolled in the MLS program are not eligible) and must not have received a previous degree at SMU.

Graduate students whose spouse is a United Methodist Minister must provide:

*Spouse: first page of current year joint tax return to demonstrate marital status

(Note: **Undergraduate students** do not need to provide tax returns; however, relationship to United Methodist Minister must be verified)

This award is a \$3,500 tuition credit each regular semester for a maximum of eight semesters of full-time undergraduate or graduate study, which must be completed within five consecutive calendar years.
