## Perkins to Waive Application Fee Through March 1, 2010

*Dallas, Texas* – Perkins School of Theology at Southern Methodist University is waiving its \$50 application fee through March 1, 2010 for applicants to the Master of Divinity, Master of Theological Studies, Master of Church Ministries, and Master of Sacred Music degree programs, as well as for all non-degree applicants. March 1, 2010 is the deadline for submitting an application for need-based grant consideration, while February 1, 2010 remains the deadline for submitting for submission of applications for merit scholarship consideration.
