## Former NFL quarterback and NFL Player of the Year Ron Jaworski to speak at the Red Mountain Resources Luncheon

DALLAS, TEXAS – Red Mountain Resources and the PwC SMU Athletic Forum welcome former NFL quarterback Ron Jaworski to Dallas on Friday, October 11, 2013.

The luncheon will begin at noon in the Khmer Ballroom of the Hilton Anatole. Media availability begins at 10:45 a.m. in the Cherry Blossom Room of the Anatole.

Jaworski was drafted by the Los Angeles Rams in 1973 and joined the Philadelphia Eagles in 1977. With Jaworski's leadership on the field, the Eagles advanced to their first-ever Super Bowl appearance. In 1980, Jaworski finished the season as the No. 1-rated passer in the NFC and was voted the 1980 NFL MVP. Until Jaworski's leg injury, he started 116 straight NFL games, which is a record for most consecutive starts as a quarterback. He held that record until 1999.

Now, Jaworski is committed to the Jaws Youth Playbook, which seeks to improve the overall health and wellness of at-risk youth. The South Jersey Chamber of Commerce awarded Jaworski the Pinnacle Award for his outstanding volunteer work and dedication to the South Jersey Chamber and business community.
