POLICE URGE CAMPUS TO BE ALERT FOR VEHICLE THIEVES

Two vehicles parked at SMU have been stolen in recent days and SMU police are urging the campus to be on the alert.

On Friday, July 20, an SMU student reported she had parked her gray 2005 Honda Accord in the South Quad Lot next to Ford Stadium at 9:30 a.m. When she returned at 2 p.m., her vehicle was gone.

On Monday, July 23, a construction worker for the George W. Bush Presidential Center said he parked his dark, gray 2003 GMC pickup truck in the parking lot in the 2900 block of SMU Boulevard at 6:20 a.m. He said when he returned to the lot at 3:30 p.m., his truck was missing.
