ON-CAMPUS CRIME ALERT STUDENT REPORTS ATTEMPTED AGGRAVATED ROBBERY

On Thursday, April 21, 2016, at approximately 3 a.m., an SMU student reported an attempted aggravated robbery to SMU Police. The student said she was walking between the north side of Owens Art Center and the south side of Peyton Hall when she was approached by a man who said, "Hand over all of your stuff." The student said "No" and ran off. She reported to police at approximately 10 a.m. Thursday, during the ongoing police investigation, that she remembered seeing the man holding a gun.

The suspect is described as a dark-skinned black male, about 180 pounds, wearing dark-blue clothing, a long-sleeved shirt and had a buzzed haircut. The suspect in this incident does not match the description of the suspect in a robbery reported to police April 17.
