

Participants should have at least five years of nonprofit work experience and have held CEO and/or executive position(s) at a nonprofit for a minimum of two years, either as a paid staff member or as a volunteer.

Participants represent a range of nonprofits in various sectors, sizes and geographies. The typical organization, however, has a broad impact and is well-established.

Ideal candidates are typically the chief executives of their nonprofits. At larger nonprofits, there may be other executives with the requisite years of experience who would make good candidates for the program. These are considered on a case-by-case basis.
