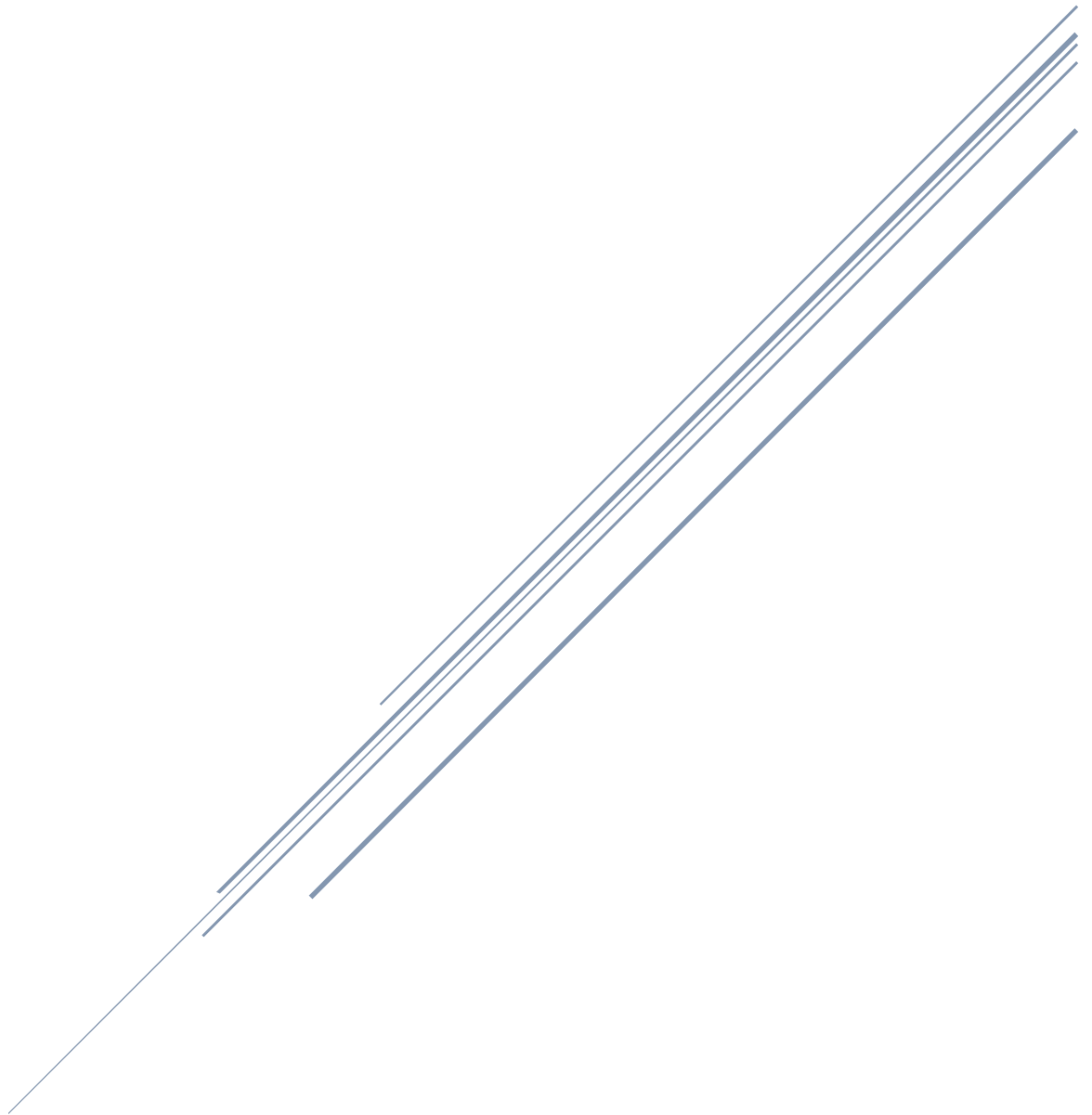

Semester	Hours
<p>Fall and Spring</p>	<p><u>24/5 Schedule:</u> The Fall and Spring semester schedules shall begin on the first day of instruction as designated by the Registrar (smu.edu/registrar). The last day of both semesters is the last day of final exams.</p> <p>Monday 24 hours Tuesday 24 hours Wednesday 24 hours Thursday 24 hours Friday 24-hour schedule ends at 6pm Saturday Noon-6pm Sunday 24-hour schedule resumes at Noon</p> <p>*South, West and North entrances lock at 9pm. No card swipe access. East and West Lobby entrances only access points to library by card swipe after 9pm until 7:30a.</p>
<p>Fall and Spring Exceptions</p>	<p><u>New Student Staff Training Period</u> In order to accommodate student hiring and training, a reduced schedule will be followed the first two+ weeks of each semester.</p> <p>For Fall: the later of (1) the first two full calendar weeks of classes or (2) the calendar week including the Labor Day holiday.</p> <p>For Spring: the first two full calendar weeks.</p> <p>The exception always ends on a Saturday after a minimum of 9 weekdays.</p> <p>Monday 7:30am – 9pm Tuesday 7:30am – 9pm Wednesday 7:30am – 9pm Thursday 7:30am – 9pm Friday 7:30am – 6pm Saturday Noon-6pm Sunday Noon-9pm</p> <hr/> <p><u>Study Hall During Final Exams Period 24/7</u> In order to accommodate the large number of patrons using the library late at night and during finals, a 24/7 schedule will be followed.</p> <p>The library will begin a 24/7 schedule the Sunday of the week preceding the week containing the last day of instruction.</p> <p>For example, the last day of instruction in the Fall 2016 semester was Monday December 5th, 2016. Study Hall began Sunday November 27th, 2016.</p> <hr/> <p><u>Last Day of Final Exams</u> The library will close at 9pm on the last day of final exams. The Intersession schedule will begin the following day.</p> <hr/> <p><u>Weekend before First Day of Instruction</u> If the first day of classes is a Monday or Tuesday, the library will be open that preceding weekend following regular Summer Hours.</p> <p>Saturday Noon – 6pm Sunday Noon – 6pm</p>

Spring Semester Exceptions

Martin Luther King Jr. Weekend

Sunday: Varies depending on whether the Spring semester has started or not. Follow Intersession schedule (closed) if not or open (9am-6pm) if classes have begun. For example, the first day of classes for Spring 2016 was January 15th, 2016. The library was open 9am-6pm on the Sunday right before the MLKJR holiday. The first day of classes for the Spring 2017 semester was January 23, 2017. The library was closed the Sunday right before the MLKJR holiday.

<p>Summer</p>	<p><u>Summer Schedule</u></p> <p>The Summer Schedule shall begin in the “First Day of Classes” of the Full Summer Session. It will end on the last day of Full Summer Session or the last day of the Second Session, whichever is later. (smu.edu/registrar)</p> <p>Monday 8am – 9pm Tuesday 8am – 9pm Wednesday 8am – 9pm Thursday 8am – 9pm Friday 8am – 6pm Saturday Noon-6pm Sunday Noon-6pm</p>
<p>Summer Exceptions</p>	<p><u>Fourth of July Holiday</u></p> <p>If the 4th of July falls on a Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday</p> <p>3rd of July 8am-6pm 4th of July Closed 5th of July Regular schedule resumes at 8am</p> <p>If the 4th of July falls on a Monday</p> <p>Saturday Regular Schedule (Noon – 6pm) Sunday Closed Monday Closed Tuesday Regular schedule resumes at 8am</p> <p>If the 4th of July falls on Friday</p> <p>Thursday 8am – 6pm Friday Closed Saturday Closed Sunday Regular schedule resumes at Noon</p>
<p>Intersessions</p>	<p><u>January, May and August Intersessions</u></p> <p>Monday 8am – 6pm Tuesday 8am – 6pm Wednesday 8am – 6pm Thursday 8am – 6pm Friday 8am – 6pm Saturday Closed Sunday Closed</p>
<p>Public Use Hours</p>	<p>The public (any patron that does not have an SMU ID) is welcome to use the Fondren Library at the following times. Outside of these times, the library is accessible only by card swipe and public patrons must leave the library.</p> <p>Monday 7:30a – 9pm Tuesday 7:30a – 9pm Wednesday 7:30a – 9pm Thursday 7:30a – 9pm Friday 7:30a – 6pm Saturday Noon – 6pm Sunday 11a – 6pm</p>

<p>Home Football Games</p>	<p>The library will be closed all Saturdays when there is a home football game. Regular hours will resume the following Sunday at noon or 11am depending on the schedule in place at the time.</p>
<p>Additional Considerations</p>	<p>A correction of hours should be submitted to Google at the following times:</p> <p>At the end of Intersession following the Spring semester, correct the hours to the Summer Schedule.</p> <p>At the end of the Intersession after Summer, correct the hours to 24/5.</p>
