Yaw Bonsu on the Admissions Technology Team has developed an internal process to eliminate manual processing of 80% of our application documents. This new process eliminates the bottle neck of thousands and thousands of documents we receive right before and after our admission application deadlines. Yaw's process has automatically indexed & linked over 17,000 documents so far this year! Now, instead of taking weeks applicant's checklist are being updated within a day or two from the time documents are received.
