## Using Dreamweaver to connect to Sites.SMU

- Launch Dreamweaver (If you do not have Dreamweaver installed, the software may be deployed from the LanDesk Desktop Manager)
- 2. Click Site
- 3. Click Manage Sites
- 4. Click New Site
- 5. Enter a name for your site
- Enter the location and folder name for the locally stored version of your site
- 7. Click the **Server** link on the left side of the window
- Click the + sign to add a new server connection
- 9. In the server name field, enter Sites.smu.edu
- 10. Change the drop down menu for Connect using to "FTP over SSL/TLS (Explicit encryption)"
- 11. Enter sites.smu.edu as the FTP address
- 12. Enter your SMU username in the format **smu\smuid** (smu\00001111)
- 13. Enter your SMU password
- 14. In the root directory, enter the **root** of your site (for example enter the text after sites.smu.edu/**oit**)
- 15. The Web URL will automatically populate.
- 16. Change the drop down menu for Authentication to "None (encryption only)"
- 17. Click **Test to** ensure you have a successful connection
- 18. Click Save
- 19. Click Save
- 20. Click Done
- 21. Use the File window at the bottom right to toggle between the Local folders and the Remote server. To upload or download files, use the arrows in that same window.
