## PLACEMENT DISCERNMENT PROCESS 2018-19 INTERNSHIP

After you submit your application, you will be assigned to work with one of the Intern faculty members during the internship placement process. Your assigned Intern Faculty supervisor will contact you to set a time for the initial placement discernment conversation and will give you the topics you should come prepared to discuss.

When you come to the first appointment, it would be helpful for you to bring with you the appropriate Course Planning Guide for your degree program and projected graduation date (see <a href="https://www.smu.edu/Perkins/FacultyAcademics/AcademicServices">www.smu.edu/Perkins/FacultyAcademics/AcademicServices</a>) with notes on your plan for your remaining classes after your most recent conversation with your academic advisor or the registrar.

Later in the placement process, you will receive information about taking the Myers-Briggs Type Indicator (MBTI), a personality assessment. The results will be interpreted for you during a workshop at Intern Orientation in August.
