

DART Pass Information



SMU participates in a DART Higher Education Pass Program and all currently enrolled students are eligible to receive an annual DART transit GoPass through the Parking and ID Card Services Office. See link below.

Please note: New students must wait 24 hours after enrollment of classes to be eligible for the DART transit GoPass.

Orders cannot be processed without a current photo on your SMU ID card account prior to ordering the DART transit GoPass.

Student DART GoPass orders take approximately 3-4 weeks. You will receive an email from DART on how to download the GoPass App and activate your phone. *Be sure not to change phones or phone numbers after ordering your GoPass, also please make sure your DART email does not get caught in your spam mail.*

Currently enrolled SMU students can request their annual DART GoPass by completing the [Student DART Request Form](#) online at a minimal cost of \$5.00. As long as you renew in consecutive years there is no renewal fee. If not renewing in consecutive year the \$5.00 fee applies. Phone number change fees may apply at DART replacement rates.

Duplicate orders will not be processed.

With a DART transit GoPass, riders are able to commute to campus by bus and rail with public transportation that is reliable and economical. Use your DART transit GoPass for your daily commute and forget the traffic hassles and the fuel and parking costs! Also, use your DART transit GoPass to get to your favorite shopping, entertainment and travel destinations that are easily accessible by public transportation such as NorthPark Mall, Downtown Dallas, Love Field, DFW Airport, the American Airlines Center, the Dallas Arts District, the Dallas World Aquarium, the Dallas Zoo and many more fun and exciting locations.

*SMU students are not eligible to purchase reduced fare passes for College/Trade School students from DART.
