- Someone who is a proactive leader and takes the time to meet students where they are and not wait for students to come to them
- Someone who establishes a strong presence in Loyd and instills pride in Loyd Commons
- Someone who is not afraid to be wrong and asks for help

The Loyd Faculty in Residence works closely with the rest of the Loyd Leadership Team to develop a mindset that seeks live out the motto and values. The Loyd Leadership Team consists of the Residential Community Director, eight Resident Assistants, Commons Council President and Executive Board, Resident Community Chaplain, Loyd Mentors, and Loyd Peer Leaders.
