June 18, 2017 ~ Athens Full Day Sightseeing with Acropolis Museum and lunch

This tour gives you an opportunity to observe the striking contrasts that make Athens such a fascinating city. Your expert guide take you to see the center of the city including Constitution Square (Syntagma), the Parliament, the Memorial to the Unknown Soldier and the National Library. On your way to the Acropolis you will see the Panathenaic Stadium (where the first Olympic Games of the modern era were held in 1896), the Temple of Olympian Zeus and Hadrian's Arch. At the Acropolis, we visit the architectural masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens: The Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion and, finally, the monument that 'puts order in the mind', the Parthenon. You will also pay a visit to the fantastic New Acropolis Museum.
