RETIRING FACULTY

JOHN J. BANEWICZ

John Banewicz received a B.S. degree from Brown University and a Ph.D. from Rice University before joining SMU in 1950. He epitomizes dedication to students. In his more than 40 years at SMU he has introduced thousands of students to the challenge and fulfillment of the study of chemistry. Professor Banewicz's research focused on the thermodynamics of decomposition of transition metal complexes and the structure and properties of intercalation compounds. His work received funding from the National Science Foundation, the Research Corporation, the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, and the Robert A. Welch Foundation. In addition to his teaching and research, he served the University with distinction as president of the SMU Faculty Senate, chair of the Department of Chemistry, a trustee of the SMU Retirement Fund, and memberships on the Undergraduate and Graduate Councils of the School of Humanities and Sciences. He also has served as chair of the Dallas Section of the American Chemical Society, president of the Texas Section of the Electrochemical Society, and a member of the Board of Directors and the Advisory Council of the Dallas Health and Science Museum. Last year Professor Banewicz was awarded the first Willis M. Tate Lecture Series Award for his exceptional service to the University community. He will retire as Professor *Emeritus* of Chemistry.

FREDERICK S. CARNEY

Frederick S. Carney holds a B.A. degree from Ursinus College, a B.D. from Garrett Theological Seminary, and a Ph.D. from The University of Chicago, and pursued postdoctoral research at Oxford University. He was appointed to the faculty of Perkins School of Theology in 1960. From 1973 to 1974 he was a Senior Research Fellow at the Kennedy Center for Bioethics, Georgetown University; from 1981 to 1982, a Fellow at the American Research Center in Egypt; and from 1987 to 1988, a Visiting Scholar at the Institute for the Advanced Study of Religion at The University of Chicago. Professor Carney has held visiting faculty appointments at several institutions. He is the editor and translator of *The Politics of Johannes Althusius*, and the author of contributions to journals and books in theology, ethics, and law. He was a founding editor of the *Journal of Religious Ethics*. He has served as a consultant and adviser to various government agencies, foundations, and other public and private institutions on medical ethics, nuclear energy, and religion and law. He will retire as Professor *Emeritus* of Ethics.

ANN M. EARLY

Ann M. Early completed a B.A. degree at Clark University, where she was a member of the first entering class to include women, and an M.A.T. degree at Harvard University. She was a faculty member at New Haven College and Dutchess Community College before joining SMU's Department of English as a lecturer in 1966. She first taught the University's celebrated general education course, "The Nature of Man." She later taught courses that explored the nature and history of women. In 1980 she was named coordinator of SMU's Women's Studies program serving until 1989. A dedicated and popular teacher, Professor Early twice has been selected by students as one of SMU's Outstanding Professors. She has received the prestigious M award for distinguished service to the University as well as the Outstanding Woman of SMU award, which was presented by the Women's Interest Network. She has been actively involved in Dallas Women's Foundation, the YWCA Women's Resources Center, and the League of Women Voters. Last year Clark University awarded Professor

Early an honorary doctor of humane letters degree in recognition of her contributions to women's studies. She will retire as Senior Lecturer *Emeritus* of English.

JAMES EARLY

James Early completed a B.A. degree at Bowdoin College and M.A. and Ph.D. degrees at Harvard University. After faculty appointments at Yale University and Vassar College, he joined SMU's Department of English as an associate professor in 1964. For 17 of nearly 30 years at SMU, Professor Early has played a significant leadership role in the life of what is now known as Dedman College of Humanities and Sciences, having served as dean of the faculties for eight years, acting dean of the School, associate dean of faculties, chair of the Department of English, and director of graduate studies in English. He has taught courses in American literature, Shakespeare, drama and fiction, the novel, and general education courses for all undergraduates. A scholar of architecture, Professor Early also has taught courses on architecture of the United States and Mexico. He has published one book on American architecture and completed another on the architecture of colonial Mexico. He also is the author of a book on William Faulkner, and his reviews have appeared in the *Yale Review*, *Southwest Review*, and *Journal of the Society of Architectural Historians*. Professor Early is a Fellow of the DeGolyer Institute of American Studies, was a founding member of the Southwest Conference Humanities Consortium, and has served on the council of the Texas Institute of Letters and the executive committee of the Texas Committee for the Humanities. He will retire as Professor *Emeritus* of English.

ELIZABETH ADELE FERGUSON

Elizabeth Adele Ferguson received a B.B.A. degree from North Texas State University and an M.F.A. degree in dance from SMU. Her multifaceted career at SMU began in 1968. Since then, she has served the University with distinction and dedication as a teacher, choreographer, and administrator. She has held positions as director of Dance Preparatory School, director of graduate studies, chair *ad interim* before becoming chair of dance in 1986. She has taught in the Master of Liberal Arts program and also has served on the Dean's Executive Council and as a member of key committees in the Faculty Senate, University Lecture Series, Teacher Preparation Council, Tenure Committees, and the Provost's Committee on Freshman Orientation.

Professor Ferguson is an active participant in the Council of Dance Administrators and the National Association of Schools of Dance, where she serves as a member of the Ethics and Research Committees. She is a member of advisory boards for Dallas' High School of Performing and Visual Arts, the Dallas Dance Council, and The International Theatrical Arts Society. A specialist in lyrical jazz and contemporary dance, her choreography credits include the 1973 American premiere of *Liberty Ranch!* at SMU, with subsequent performances at regional theatres and at The Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C. Professor Ferguson received the Meadows Distinguished Teaching Award in 1984 and a Mustang Award for Outstanding Professor in 1977. She will retire as Associate Professor *Emeritus* of Dance.

WILLIAM K. McELVANEY

William K. McElvaney holds B.B.A., M.B.A., and M.Div. degrees from SMU and pursued further graduate study at Union Theological Seminary in New York City. After distinguished service in pastoral appointments in the North Texas Annual Conference of The United Methodist Church, he was appointed president of Saint Paul School of Theology in Kansas City, Missouri, a post he held for 12 years. He joined the faculty of Perkins School of Theology in 1985 as the LeVan Professor of Preaching and Worship. His long-standing concern for

issues of social justice is reflected in books he has written on ministry, preaching, spirituality, and the church, as well as in his teaching and community involvement. He holds honorary degrees from Southwestern University and Central Methodist College, and was the recipient of SMU's Distinguished Alumnus Award in 1980. In 1988 the William K. McElvane Chair in Preaching was established in his honor at Saint Paul School of Theology. He will retire as LeVan Professor *Emeritus* of Preaching and Worship.

LUÍS MARTÍN

Born in Seville, Spain, Luís Martín pursued his formal education in Spain, Japan, Canada, and the United States, and completed a Ph.D. degree in Latin American history at Columbia University in 1966. An ordained priest, he joined the faculty of SMU's Department of History in 1968 after appointments at Sophia University in Tokyo and the University of Puerto Rico. He was named the Edmund and Louise Kahn Professor of History in 1973 and held the endowed chair with distinction for nearly 20 of his 25 years of exceptional service to SMU, its students, and the Dallas community. An authority on the history of Peru and colonial Latin America, Professor Martín has written numerous articles and four books. He is one of the most popular instructors at SMU and has received awards for faculty excellence from student and alumni groups, including three Outstanding Professor awards, an M award, the first SMU Alumni Association Award for Faculty Excellence, and a nomination to the Outstanding Educators of America. He served as chair of the Department of History and as director of the Master of Liberal Arts program, and he helped found SMU's study-abroad programs in Madrid and Toledo, Spain. Professor Martín served as president of the Southwest Historical Association and was a panelist and consultant for the National Endowment for the Humanities. The Dallas Historical Society honored him last year for his contributions to education, and in 1988 Spain's King Juan Carlos I appointed him to the Royal Order of Civic Merit. Professor Martín will retire as the Edmund and Louise Kahn Professor *Emeritus* of History.

RICHARD T. MURRAY

Richard T. Murray received a B.A. degree from SMU and an M.Div. degree from Union Theological Seminary in New York City. He pursued further graduate study at Teacher's College at Columbia University, the University of Indiana, and the University of Pittsburgh. He is an ordained elder in The United Methodist Church and has served in various pastoral and administrative posts before joining the faculty of Perkins School of Theology in 1965. He is the author of three books, several articles, and curriculum resources in Christian education. A highly respected teacher, Professor Murray has led conferences, pastors' schools, seminars, and workshops throughout the United States. He will retire as Seneker Professor *Emeritus* of Christian Education.

LADISLAV P. NOVAK

A native of Czechoslovakia, Ladislav Novak received a B.S. degree from Charles University in Prague before coming to the United States to complete M.A. and Ph.D. degrees at the University of Minnesota. He joined SMU's Department of Anthropology in 1972 after serving on the faculty at the University of Minnesota and as a consultant with the Department of Laboratory Medicine at the Mayo Clinic and Foundation. His scholarly interests have included body composition in health and disease, human growth and development, physiology of exercise, and the biological aging process. During his 21 years at SMU, he has taught 5,000 students, ranging from first-year students through doctoral candidates. He is the author or co-author of 75 articles, and his work has appeared in *Human Biology*, *American Journal of Cardiology*, *Journal of Sports Medicine*, and *American Journal of Physical Anthropology*. In recognition of his outstanding research in biological anthropology, Professor Novak

was presented a commemorative medal in 1990 by the president of the Czechoslovakian Academy of Sciences. He has served as a research physiologist for the 1972 Olympic Games, a consultant to the Education and Research Program of the government of Bahrain, a reviewer of grant proposals for the National Academy of Sciences, and a member of the Professional Advisory Council of Dallas Geriatric Research Institute. Professor Novak is a Fellow of the International College of Pediatrics and the International Organization for the Study of Human Development, and is a founding member of the International Association of Human Biologists. He will retire as Professor *Emeritus* of Anthropology.

SCHUBERT M. OGDEN

Schubert M. Ogden received a B.A. degree from Ohio Wesleyan University and B.D. and Ph.D. degrees from The University of Chicago, and also holds honorary degrees from both universities. He has received Fulbright and Guggenheim research fellowships, is past president of the American Academy of Religion, and in 1985 was elected a Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. He is the author of six books and of contributions to 50 others, as well as of numerous articles and reviews. He also is the editor and translator of two volumes of the writings of Rudolf Bultmann. A *Festschrift* in his honor was published by The University of Chicago Press in 1989. He taught at Perkins School of Theology from 1956 to 1969, then served as University Professor of Theology at The University of Chicago for three years, and returned to the Perkins faculty in 1972. He was director of the Graduate Program in Religious Studies from 1974 to 1990 and was named University Distinguished Professor of Theology in 1983. One of the leading theologians of his generation, Professor Ogden has given intellectual leadership to the University and to the Church. He will retire as University Distinguished Professor *Emeritus* of Theology.

DAVID K. SWITZER

David K. Switzer received a B.A. degree from Southwestern University, a B.D. from Emory University, an M.A. from The University of Texas at Austin, and a Th.D. from the Southern California School of Theology. An ordained elder with pastoral experience in The United Methodist Church, Professor Switzer joined Perkins School of Theology in 1967. In addition to his teaching responsibilities, he has served the school as its associate dean (1967-71) and as counseling chaplain (1971-78). He was an exchange professor at Kwansai Gakuin University in Japan, and held a postdoctoral fellowship at Timberlawn Foundation for Psychiatric Education and Research. He has published several books that have been widely used as textbooks in pastoral care. His work on crisis counseling has established him as a leader in the field. He will retire as Professor *Emeritus* of Pastoral Theology.

BACCALAUREATE PREACHER

The Reverend Dr. Carole Cotton-Winn, preacher for this year's Baccalaureate Service, is the first woman to be appointed District Superintendent in the Louisiana Conference of The United Methodist Church. She has served as Lake Charles District Superintendent since 1990. Reverend Cotton-Winn, a native of Louisiana, earned a B.A. degree in 1965 from Centenary College in Shreveport. She received her seminary education from SMU's Perkins School of Theology, where she earned a B.D. degree in 1970 and received the Outstanding Senior Award.

She has been a member of the Louisiana Annual Conference since 1970, when she was ordained a deacon. Reverend Cotton-Winn was the first woman seminarian to serve as a probationary member and a deacon in Louisiana. She served her first appointments as associate minister at Aurora United Methodist Church and Rayne Memorial United Methodist Church in New Orleans. She later served at Brownville United Methodist Church in West Monroe.

Reverend Cotton-Winn and her husband, the Reverend John M. Winn Jr. have pioneered as a clergy couple in the Louisiana Conference. They were appointed as co-pastors to First United Methodist Church in Houma in 1978. The couple also served as co-pastors from 1968 to 1990 at the Aldersgate United Methodist Church in Slidell.

Through her ministerial career, Reverend Cotton-Winn has been active at the district, conference, and general levels of The United Methodist Church. She currently serves on the Commission on the General Conference until 1996. From 1988 to 1990, Reverend Cotton-Winn returned to Perkins School of Theology to serve in the Young Pastor's Mentor Program.

CONFERRING OF HONORARY DEGREES

MICHAEL S. BROWN and JOSEPH L. GOLDSTEIN, Doctor of Science

Molecular geneticists at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas, Michael S. Brown and Joseph L. Goldstein have transformed scientific knowledge about the way in which cells and blood interact. Their research has produced insights into fundamental biological phenomena and processes. They have ingeniously combined concepts and methods from various fields such as genetics, biochemistry, and cell biology to study the regulation of cholesterol at the cellular and whole body level. In 1985, they shared the Nobel Prize for their discoveries which "revolutionized our knowledge about the regulation of cholesterol metabolism and the treatment of diseases caused by abnormally elevated cholesterol levels in the blood." The National Academy of Sciences elected them to membership in 1980, and they have received numerous other scientific honors and prizes, including the U.S. National Medal of Science in 1988.

In recognition of the enormous impact of their work, their achievements as clinical investigators and teachers, and their exemplary role as physician-scientists, Southern Methodist University is honored to confer upon Michael S. Brown and Joseph L. Goldstein the degree of Doctor of Science, *honoris causa*.

MARIAN WRIGHT EDELMAN, Doctor of Humane Letters

Tenacious champion of the rights of the young, Marian Wright Edelman saw that the nation's future was being determined each day in the bodies, minds, and spirits of every American child. Growing up in the segregated South, she managed to see beyond the limitations society had placed upon her own potential. To break down the barriers for others, she participated in civil rights protests and voter registration drives as a student at

Spelman College and at Yale University's Law School. While working in Washington, D.C., she saw that stronger advocacy was needed for the most innocent victims of social injustice: the nation's children. She founded the Children's Defense Fund believing that the needs of children, especially poor children, should be central to the public policy of a nation whose future would be at great risk if its children were at risk. Under her leadership, the Children's Defense Fund has become one of the most effective national organizations representing health and education issues affecting families and children. For her extraordinary accomplishments as an advocate, author, and attorney, and for her dedication to a cause that will determine the quality of our collective futures, Southern Methodist University is honored to confer upon Marian Wright Edelman the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*.

KENNETH PREWITT, Doctor of Humane Letters

Distinguished scholar, author, and advocate of developing nations, Kenneth Prewitt has enlarged our understanding of the democratic system in America and furthered the cause of scientific philanthropy around the world. He was graduated from SMU in 1958 with a degree in history and political science. After receiving a Ph.D. in political science from Stanford University, he was appointed co-director of Stanford's "Comparative Studies of Legislature Behavior in Small Decision-Making Groups." Later, during 14 years on the faculty of The University of Chicago, he published five books on institutional racism in America, on the function of political elites in democratic societies, and on ways in which people mobilize and exert pressure on elected leaders at the local level. He served with great distinction as president of the Social Science Research Council. More recently, as vice president and now senior vice president of the Rockefeller Foundation, he has worked to concentrate that organization's efforts on the areas of international, science-based development. The hand of Kenneth Prewitt, once a teacher and research fellow in Uganda and Kenya, may be seen in the Rockefeller Foundation's promotion of African studies programs at U.S. colleges and universities and in its fellowships for African scholars to study in this country. For his leadership and scholarship advancing knowledge of racial and political forces locally and globally, Southern Methodist University is honored to confer upon Kenneth Prewitt the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*.

THE ACADEMIC PROCESSION

The academic procession and the regalia worn by the faculty and officers of the University symbolically represent the continuing link between the modern American university and the founding of the great medieval universities in Europe — chief among them Bologna, Paris, and Oxford. As those institutions were derived from the Catholic Church, the universities adopted many of the ceremonial trappings of the Church in their official public functions.

The mace of the University, a symbol of the authority vested in the President by the Board of Trustees and representing the covenant between the President and the faculty, is borne by the President of the Faculty Senate, elected by representatives of all faculties (this year, Professor Edward R. Biehl of the Chemistry Department). Though the order of the procession varies from university to university, at Southern Methodist University it proceeds from the chief marshal through the ranks of the faculty and the officers of the University, to the President, who is preceded by the mace-bearer. At Commencement, the candidates for graduation precede the faculty.

The caps and gowns worn in the procession also vary from place to place. There are variations in design to indicate the degrees held by the wearers, and many universities in America have introduced colorful gowns and other distinguishing details (in place of the customary clerical black from which all originated). The bachelor's gown is a simple robe falling in straight lines from an elaborate yoke. Its distinguishing characteristic is the long pointed sleeves. Master's gowns are arranged so that the arm emerges from a long sleeve through a slit at the wrist (replacing a former slit at the elbow). In most cases, the doctor's gown is marked by velvet panels down the front and around the neck, and by three bars of the same material on the bell-shaped sleeves. It is cut much fuller than the other gowns, and may be ornamented in color. Faculty colors are occasionally seen in the sleeve bars and paneling.

The caps, too, vary according to the customs of the university from which the wearer received a degree. While most American universities adopted the "mortarboard" style of Oxford, others have chosen styles based on other European institutions. The color of the tassel worn with the cap may be black for any degree; or, the color may be that of the faculty of the major field of learning (e.g. Arts, Engineering, Law, etc.). Persons holding doctoral degrees and governing officials of institutions are entitled to wear tassels of gold metallic thread. Such tassels are usually sewn in place. It is common practice, although not universal, that a ceremony is made of moving the tassel from the right side to the left of the cap at the moment the degree is awarded.

Within the great varieties of styles and colors in gowns and caps, there has been one universally accepted code for the hood worn trailing down the wearer's back. Originally, it was like the hood on the habit worn by monks — and very useful, for protection against the weather and even for begging for alms. Nowadays, the hood through length and color shows the degree and the specialization of the wearer, and the university that granted the degree. The bachelor's, master's, and doctor's hoods are three feet, three and one-half feet, and four feet long, respectively. The velvet trimming in the same order is two, three and five inches wide. The color of the trim identifies the faculty. A partial list of faculty colors follows:

The lining of the hood — that portion most visible from the rear — indicates the institution awarding the degree. SMU's hood lining, for example, is blue with a red chevron.

Through these colorful ceremonies, SMU symbolically displays the continuity of its educational purposes with the origins of organized learning in the Western world.
