Classes are offered for 3.0 term hours credit, except for HR 8037, which is 1.5 hours. You may take one course only. Advance registration begins November 8 for seniors, November 6 for all others. The tuition charge of \$475.00 per hour must be paid by **Monday, December 19th**, online by e-check or in the Cashier's Office. There will be no contracts. All accounts are due and payable on that date. If you register and then decide later that you cannot attend, you must notify us before classes begin. Otherwise, you will be charged the entire amount by SMU. Canceling after registration and before classes begin results in a 5% of tuition charge. There is no refund if you withdraw after classes begin. Final exams, if given, are during the last class period.

Do not enroll online. Course request forms must be brought to 206 Kirby, mailed to P O Box 750133, or faxed (214-768-4245). The Registrar will enroll each student. Forms should be submitted by December 1, 2011.
