The class of 2016, which comprises graduates from August and December 2015 as well as May 2016, includes candidates for graduation with the following degrees:

- Master of Divinity: 56
- Master of Arts in Ministry: 4
- Master of Sacred Music: 5
- Master of Theological Studies: 17
- Master of Theology: 3
- Doctor of Ministry: 12

Among students in the May graduating class, 57 are United Methodists. Other faith traditions represented include African Methodist Episcopal, Baptist, Catholic, Church of God, Christian Methodist Episcopal, Congregational, Episcopal, Methodist Church in Kenya, Pentecostal, and Presbyterian as well as a number of students who classify their affiliation as nondenominational.

Graduating students come from a number of different United Methodist Annual (Regional) Conferences, including North Alabama, Florida, Great Plains, Louisiana, Missouri, Western North Carolina, Oklahoma, Texas, Central Texas, North Texas, Northwest Texas, and Rio Texas. Other interesting graduation facts about candidates for graduation in the Class of 2015:

- The youngest graduating student is 23 and the oldest is 69.
- The class of 2016 includes the first graduates of the new Master of Theology degree.
- The class includes international students from Kenya, Indonesia, and Taiwan.
- Graduates include a wife and husband both receiving their M.Div. degree.
