- □ Fill out the student portion of the Official Transcript Request and School Report and give it to your college counselor.
- □ Enclose a \$60 nonrefundable application fee (check or money order) payable to SMU in the same envelope that contains your application.
- Optional: You may also submit a recommendation from a teacher of your choice. If you choose to do so, visit smu.edu/forms to print the Teacher Recommendation form to give to your reference.

Important: Your application is **not** considered complete until we have received your official high school transcript, including test record, SAT (code 6660) or ACT (code 4174) test scores, and school report from your college counselor.
