Oxford Dictionary of the Christian Church

The online version contains the same articles as the print version, with hyperlinks to cross-references. Bibliographies are also included, with links to the library catalog.

ATLA Religion Database with ATLASerials

The ATLA Religion Database is an essential tool for the study of religion. It is the premier index to journal articles, book reviews, and collections of essays in all fields of religion. Some full-text articles are available.

Academic Search Complete

ASC provides full text for several thousand peer-reviewed titles. PDF back files to 1975 are available for nearly 100 journals, and searchable cited references are provided for more than 1,000 titles.

Biblical Archeology Society Online Archive

Contains access to three journals, *Biblical Archaeology Review*, *Bible Review*, and *Archaeology Odyssey* and five e-books, *Ancient Israel*, *Aspects of Monotheism*, *Feminist Approaches to the Bible*, *The Rise of Ancient Israel*, and *The Search for Jesus*.

JStor

An archive of full-text scholarly journals, offering researchers the ability to retrieve high-resolution, scanned images of journal issues and pages as they were originally designed, printed, and illustrated. These journals span many disciplines, including Classical Studies, History, Philosophy, and Religion.
