

SMU Retiree Medical Eligibility

- Age 60
- Ten years of SMU service
- Five Consecutive Years in Medical Plan immediately prior to retirement
- Married to spouse five years prior to retirement or a qualified Statement of Domestic Partnership established five years prior to retirement

Emeriti Group Medical Plans

- One Medicare coordination plan
- Two Medicare supplemental plans (availability based on state approval)
- One Medicare Advantage PPO (Extended Service Area (ESA) available for geographical areas outside Aetna's network)



Emeriti Rx Plans*

- Rx High Plan – continuing coverage in coverage gap
- Rx Mid Plan – generic coverage only in coverage gap
- Rx Low Plan – no coverage in coverage gap
