

On Thursday, May 5, 2016, at approximately 11:30 p.m., an SMU student reported a robbery to SMU Police. The student said she was walking between the north side of Owen Arts Center and the south side of Mary Hay Hall and Peyton Hall when a man approached her, grabbed her arm, robbed her of her property and fled. The student said she did not see a weapon. SMU Police and University Park Police searched the area but did not locate the suspect.

The suspect is described as an adult black male with facial hair, weighing 220 pounds and about 5 feet, 10 inches tall. He was wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, white T-shirt, dark pants and light-colored tennis shoes.
