UNDERGRADUATE COUNCIL
Minutes from October 18, 2003

The Undergraduate Council met on Friday, October 18, at 3:00 p.m. in 121 Dallas Hall. Present: Deans Kathy Hayes and Lisa Johnston, Professors Christine Buchanan, Thomas Arp, David Wilson, Raj Deb and Mike Lattman, and student representative Andrea Betts. Faculty guests: Victoria Lockwood, Robert Gregory and Jason McKenna.

The Committee elected by acclamation Professor Thomas Arp as secretary of the Undergraduate Council this year.

The minutes for the September 13, 2002, meeting were approved.

New Course Proposal: ANTH 3336: *Gender and Globalization*

Professor Victoria Lockwood was present to answer questions about ANTH 3336. The Council **approved** this course proposal.

New Course Proposal: GEOL 3359: *Computer Methods in Geological Sciences*

Professor Robert Gregory and Dr. Jason McKenna attended the meeting regarding this course proposal. If this course is approved, GEOL 3159, a one-hour version of the same course, will be deleted. The Council **approved** this course proposal.

Discussion regarding title changes

The Council decided that any title change requests should be approved by the Undergraduate Council.

Discussion of internship program

There was discussion about reviewing the internship program. The Council would like to know if other universities' internship programs allow both credit and pay to students and if other universities allow summer internships with pay for which credit can be given during the fall semester. The Council would also like clearer information about the participating business or institutions and the title of the student paper and evidence of what the student achieved during the internship. The Council asked for clarification of who is mentoring the student when more than one department is listed as the student's major. Dean Hayes will present these requests to Jeanene Anderson, director of the internship program, and ask that her report be done by February 15, 2003. Dean Hayes plans to talk with students and their mentors after the internship experience.
