“Reading the Bible After the Holocaust”

The lecture will reexamine a variety of texts from the Hebrew Bible (Tanak or Old Testament) in reference to the theological and moral dilemmas posed by the Holocaust. Texts to be considered include Isaiah's call narrative (Isaiah 6), the Book of Esther, the Song of Songs, and Eve in the Garden of Eden (Genesis 3).
