

Spanish Major Requirements for Non-Native Spanish Speakers

Non-native Spanish students who matriculate in Fall 2013 or thereafter must accumulate a total of 30 term hours of advanced courses beyond 2302 to complete the Spanish major. These ten courses must include the following:

¹ All 3000-level courses must be taken before registering for any 5000-level course; exceptions will be made for Study Abroad courses. Individual courses may have prerequisites).

² The electives must be from the same level as highest level course the student is taking. The student cannot take electives from a level lower than the level in which s/he is enrolled. E.g. if the student is taking 5000-level courses, the elective can only be another 5000-level course, and not a 3000 or 4000-level course.
