Your first responsibility is to discuss your student's ideas and help her/him develop them into a viable proposal. For more information about the project and your responsibilities, please review the Engaged Learning Project, Application and Mentor Program links on the website www.smu.edu/EngagedLearning.

As part of the application process, you are required to review your student's written project proposal and sign at the bottom with a statement that indicates your approval. The application also asks you for a letter of recommendation addressed to the Engaged Learning Selection Panel. Please include the following information:

- Name of SMU student
- Title of Engaged Learning project
- Your insight about the project
- Your intended role
- Impact you think the project will have on the target population or community of practice
- Impact you think it will have on the student
- Your approval and support

Please email the letter to engagedlearning@smu.edu (indicate *MENTOR REC-STUDENT NAME* in subject line).

The deadline to receive your letter is February 15 unless the student lets you know that s/he is applying for one of the other application cycles: early decision (deadline December 15), senior cycle (September 30). Your SMU student will inform you of the panel decision.
