

Faculty Position in Structural Engineering Southern Methodist University

The Civil and Environmental Engineering Department is seeking applicants for a tenure-track assistant professor position in structural engineering (Position No. 6016). Candidates must have earned a doctorate in civil or structural engineering or a closely related field. The successful candidate is expected to build a recognized research program in his or her area of specialization and interest.

SMU is a private university dedicated to academic excellence. Located in Dallas, SMU has around 12,000 students. The Civil and Environmental Engineering Department resides within the Bobby B. Lyle School of Engineering and is located in the Embrey Engineering Building, a LEED Gold certified facility completed in 2006.
