

Youth Director

This full-time position is responsible for being an integral part of our congregation and helping lead our congregation and youth into a meaningful relationship with Jesus Christ. The Youth Director position will include casting vision for the Youth Ministry, delivering group messages, leading small group Bible studies, managing a team of volunteers, being highly relational, and supporting the entire youth ministry and church with its mission, vision, and strategy. Additional duties will include becoming a vital part of the community, assisting in leading worship and being a vital part of the pastoral team of the church.

As with all FUMC Wellington positions, this person is expected to embody the mission of FUMC Wellington each and every day: to help people become deeply devoted followers of Christ. They are also expected to demonstrate the values of FUMC Wellington, which include: (1) being God led, (2) caring for one another, (3) being respectful of our heritage and (4) being focused on our future.
