3. Completed at least two-years of formal training from an accredited school or Christian education program of theology focusing on church administration, counseling and/or youth development.

OR

4. Completed at least three (3) years of experience working in a leadership role directly with youth ministry in a medium (200-500 members) or large (1000 plus) size church setting.

AND

5. Must voluntarily consent to, and successfully clear a personal background and credit check.

- B. Must have a heart for the ministry of Mount Pisgah Missionary Baptist Church and demonstrate an on-going relationship with Jesus Christ through regular prayer, Bible study, and worship attendance.
- C. The youth pastor must have a love for God, a love for youth, and a pastoral heart to see them grow in their relationship with Christ.
- D. Commitment to MPMBC's doctrine, vision, values, and beliefs.

- F. Commitment to a team approach to ministry.
- G. Strong teacher with a love for God's word.
- H. Relational style of leadership and ministry.

- K. Must possess the desire to aid the Pastor in fulfilling his responsibilities and lighten his load whenever possible.
