# **Keyboard Proficiency and Score Reading Competencies for MSM Choral Concentration and MM Choral Conducting Degrees**

A Keyboard Proficiency and Score Reading Competency Exam will be administered to all incoming M.S.M. Choral Concentration and M.M. Choral Conducting students. If the exam is not passed initially, these skills and competencies may be developed either through individual preparation or review courses (PERB 5107/5108: Keyboard Skills for Choral Conductors). PERB 5107 and PERB 5108 are remedial and do not count toward the master's degree nor are they funded by scholarship.

At the initial offering of the exam upon entrance, a student may pass some sections but not others. All parts of the Keyboard Proficiency and Score Reading Competency Exam must be passed by the end of the student's third semester.

### **Keyboard Proficiency and Score Reading Competency Requirements**

#### **Keyboard Proficiency:**

- 1) Play all major and minor scales in four octaves with one hand at moderate tempo
- 2) Play all major and minor arpeggios in two octaves with one hand at moderate tempo
- 3) Play I (i) IV (iv) V7 I in all major and minor keys in four voices, two hands
- 4) Provide a simple harmonization of a major, minor, or modal folk melody with five minutes' preparation.

#### **Score Reading:**

1) Play smoothly and with appropriate tempo any two of twenty previously prepared hymns (from different style periods) from a list drawn from *The United Methodist Hymnal*. <sup>1</sup> The student may choose one hymn, and the faculty will choose the second one.

- 2) Play smoothly and with appropriate tempo two of ten previously prepared anthem accompaniments assigned by the faculty. Copies of these will be mailed in advance of the examination. <sup>2</sup> The student may choose one anthem, and the faculty will choose the second one.
- 3) Play a Bach chorale in condensed score with preparation at an appropriate, steady pace. A chorale will be selected by the faculty from a list. <sup>3</sup>
- 4) From the open score of Tomás Luis de Victoria's *O Magnum Mysterium* (Arista edition, SATB in G and F clefs), play any material from mm. 1–39 (first section) in full texture or any combination of voices. A copy will be mailed in advance of the examination.
