Position Descriptions:

Peer Dialogue Leaders (Multicultural Student Affairs Office): Student leaders help facilitate programs and discussion around diversity and social justice related topics in the residential commons (RCs) and the campus community.

Peer Academic Leaders (Academic Advising): Student leaders help fellow undergraduates understand the University Curriculum and educate their residential community about advising resources (Degree Progress Report, Class Search and Enroll) through peer mentoring, creative programming and presentations.

Peer Health Educators (Health Center): Student leaders educate residents about health related issues through group dialogue as well as active and passive programs

- Willing to live in on campus housing through the Spring 2016
- Passionately interested in shaping the Residential Commons at SMU

- Will not be a Resident Assistant for the academic year 2015-2016
