Within the Annette Caldwell Simmons School of Education and Human Development, Southern Methodist University's Graduate Liberal Studies program (GLS) is accepting applications for each fall semester beginning in 2015. Applications received by June 1st will receive priority review; applications received after that date are reviewed on a rolling basis until admission decisions are complete.

To maintain the high degree of individualized attention to each doctoral student, the DLS program will enroll a cohort of 15-20 highly competitive students per year.

Criteria for Admission: The SMU Doctor of Liberal Studies program seeks intellectually serious adult students who have earned their master's degree in a field related to their plans for advanced study. SMU encourages students with strong academic qualifications and outstanding professional/community leadership backgrounds, who have a passion for advanced interdisciplinary study with the intention of making high-level contributions to their workplace, society and the world to apply.

How to Apply: To apply for admission to the Doctor of Liberal Studies program, you must submit the following for consideration:

• Completion of the SMU application

The application is downloadable from website as well: <u>www.smu.edu/dls/admission.asp</u>).

- Official "sealed" undergraduate transcripts from all previous undergraduate and graduate study You must request that official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended be sent directly by the registrar of each institution. A GPA of 3.0 or higher and graduate GPA of 3.5 or higher is desired.
- Letter of Purpose

The Doctor of Liberal Studies (DLS) is designed for the experienced adult learner who has earned a master's degree but craves an opportunity to do and be more by pursuing rigorous interdisciplinary study guided by their own intellectual passion and commitment to the community. In a three-page essay, which must be included with your application, discuss the curricular area you would like to focus on as well as the ideas and questions you would like to read, write and think about, and how doing so through this program will enrich your life, your workplace/profession and have a substantive impact on society. Please include prior inquiry and experiences, formal or informal, which have influenced your decision to apply to the program.

• Academic Writing Sample

Please submit a recent (preferably within the past five years) research-based academic writing sample, 10-15 pages. If this is unavailable, other writing samples of comparable length may be substituted with approval from the Graduate Liberal Studies directors.

• Three Letters of Recommendation

At least one letter should be from a professor from a prior graduate program who can attest to the applicant's academic proficiency to participate in a doctoral program and one letter should be from a direct supervisor in your organization.

- Resume/Curriculum Vita
- Personal Interview

An interview with the Program Director and Faculty Chair is *mandatory*.

• Application Fee

\$75 (checks or money orders may be made payable to Southern Methodist University). Credit card payments cannot be accepted.

• The GRE (Graduate Record Examination)

The GRE is **not** required, but applicants are welcome to submit their scores if they feel the scores would add to the strength of their application.
