Tournament Structure: Teams will play a round robin regular season to be seeded into a single elimination playoff bracket.

Rules & Regulations: NIRSA Flag Football rules will govern all play except where SMU Intramural rules differ. For more information about rules visit the SMU Intramural Website or Office.

Player/Roster: An official team will consist of 7 players (8 CR). A minimum of 5 players (6 CR) must be present at game time to avoid a forfeit. All SMU students, faculty, and staff are eligible to participate. Rosters are limited to 20 participants.

Leagues Offered: Open, Fraternity, Women's, Residence Hall, & CoRec. Player may be on maximum of 2 Open teams and only 1 CoRec, Fraternity, Women's or Res Hall team.

Entry Fee: A \$30 entry fee must be paid when registering a team.

GENERAL INFORMATION

When you sign your team up you are picking the time that you want to play so come early to get the best spots. This is the time that you will play each week for the entire season. Teams will be taken on a first come first serve basis which means you need to sign up early to be guaranteed the time spot in which you want to play. Below is an explanation of each league with days and times of play.

How to Sign Up

1. Obtain the appropriate entry form in the Intramural Sports Office. (Room 113 DedmanCenter)
2. Fill it out completely, including address, **TEAM ROSTER WITH SMU ID #'s** and choose a time slot to play BY THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE.
3. Entry fees must be paid at this time.
4. Check the flyer for important information, including dates and times of the mandatory captain's meetings.

Fraternity - Each player must be a member of the fraternity for which they play (limit 1 roster/player).

Women's Open - All Women are welcome to participate (limit 1 roster/player).

Women's 1: Wednesdays 7:30 pm

Residence Hall League - Each player must be a resident of the dorm in which they play (limit 1 roster/player)

Res Hall 1: Mondays 6:30 pm

Res Hall 2: Mondays 6:30 pm

Men's Open 1- This league is open to all who would like to participate (limit 2 rosters/player).

Open 2: Monday 9:30 pm

Open 6: Wednesday 9:30 pm

Open 3: Monday 10:30 pm

CoRec Leagues- Consists of 4 men and 4 women on a team (limit 1 roster/player)

Eligibility/Forfeits:

All students enrolled at SMU, as well as faculty and staff are eligible to participate in the Intramural program. This participation is dependent on guidelines of Intramural Eligibility which may be found in the Intramural Office or on the SMU Intramural website.

Game time is forfeit time. Any team not prepared to play at game time will receive a forfeit and any consequences associated with a forfeit.

Player eligibility is the Team Captain's responsibility. Lack of knowledge of the rules will not be acceptable excuse for non-compliance.
