Play Begins: Games will begin on Wednesday September 3rd.

Tournament Structure: Teams will play a round robin regular season to be seeded into a single elimination playoff bracket.

Equipment: All participants are required to wear shin guards. Game balls will be provided by SMU Intramurals, but personal equipment may be used if both teams agree.

Player/Roster: An official team will consist of 8 players including a goalie. A minimum of 6 players must be present to avoid a forfeit.

Leagues Offered: Open, Fraternity, Residence Halls, Women's & Co-Rec.

Entry Fee: A \$30 entry fee must be paid when registering a team.

GENERAL INFORMATION

When you sign your team up you are picking the time that you want to play so come early to get the best spots. This is the time that you will play each week for the entire season. Teams will be taken on a first come first serve basis which means you need to sign up early to be guaranteed the time spot in which you want to play. Below is an explanation of each league with days and times of play.

How to Sign Up

1. Obtain the appropriate entry form in the Intramural Sports Office. (Room 113 DedmanCenter)
2. Fill it out completely, including address, **TEAM ROSTER WITH SMU ID #'s** and choose a time slot to play. Entry fees must be paid at this time.
3. Check the flyer for important information, including dates and times of the mandatory captain's meetings.

Unattached Individuals

Persons who have yet to get on a team may come by the Intramural Sports office and sign up on the draft list. New teams will be formed from this list, numbers permitting.

League Explanation

Men's Greek- Each player must be a member of the fraternity in which they play.

Women's Open- Women's only division.
Wednesday 6:30 pm

Open - This league is open to all who would like to participate.
Open 1 - Monday 9:30 pm
Open 2 - Mondays 10:30 pm
Open 3 - Wednesday 7:30 pm
Open 3 - Wednesday 8:30 pm

CoRec Leagues- Consists of 4 men and 4 women on a team.
CoRec 1 - Monday 7:30 pm
CoRec 2 - Monday 8:30 pm
CoRec 3 - Tuesday 8:30 pm
CoRec 4 - Tuesday 9:30 pm
CoRec 5 - Wednesday 9:30 pm

Eligibility/Forfeits:

All students enrolled at SMU, as well as faculty and staff are eligible to participate in the Intramural program. This participation is dependent on guidelines of Intramural Eligibility which may be found in the Intramural Office.

A player is limited to only two teams per division (ex. One Greek and one open or two open teams, no fraternity) The first team an individual plays with is the team they will remain on for the season.

Game time is forfeit time. Any team not prepared to play at game time will receive a forfeit and any consequences associated with a forfeit.

TEAM CAPTAINS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ELIGIBILITY OF ALL TEAM MEMBERS. LACK OF KNOWLEDGE OF THE RULES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTABLE EXCUSE FOR NON-COMPLIANCE. THE ABOVE RULES ARE SIMPLY A BRIEF OVERVIEW.
