Teambuilder du Jour: Water Carry

Place 10 paper cups of water, about 3/4 full, at one end of a room or outdoor area. The cups should be spread out as much as possible. Place an empty tray at the other end of the area. Your group's objective is to carry the cups of water, one at a time, and place them on the tray. The trick is that they may only use one foot and one hand for this task. If a cup of water spills, the facilitator takes the cup, refills it with water, and places it back with the others. The participants will try to hop on one leg to take the cups of water to the other end, but this results in too much spilling. The secret to accomplishing this task is teamwork—the group should stand in a line and pass each cup from person to person. To debrief, discuss the importance of teamwork, how it feels to be frustrated with a seemingly impossible task, and how it felt when they were ultimately successful.
