



John Goodwin Tower '53 led a remarkable life of leadership and public service. From 1961 to 1985, he served as a U.S. senator from Texas, his tenure culminating in the chairmanship of the Committee on Armed Services. After his Senate service, he served as a member of the U.S. arms negotiation team in Geneva and chairman of the Tower Commission in 1987 investigating the Iran-Contra scandal. Senator Tower served as a member of the SMU Board of Trustees from 1968 to 1987. He and his daughter Marian G. Tower died in the crash of a commercial aircraft near Brunswick, Georgia, on April 5, 1991. His legacy of service and leadership lives on through the John Goodwin Tower Center for Political Studies, which carries out the commitment of the late U.S. senator and SMU alumnus to educate and inspire a new generation of thoughtful leaders.
