

Campus Crime Alert: Aggravated Robbery at CVS near corner of Mockingbird and Central Expressway

On April 23, 2016, at approximately 2:10 a.m., an employee of CVS Pharmacy at 3012 Mockingbird Lane reported an aggravated robbery to University Park Police. Two employees and no customers were in the store when the suspect entered with a gun and took money from a cash register.

The suspect is described a black male, approximately 6 feet tall and weighing about 180 to 200 pounds. He was wearing a black hoodie, with the hood tightly tied around his head. He was driving a dark-colored 4-door sedan. The car entered the parking lot at CVS traveling westbound from Central Expressway and exited southbound on the Central Expressway service road.

This incident is being investigated by University Park Police.

It is not believed that this case is related to the April 17 aggravated robbery on SMU Boulevard. A suspect in that case was arrested by University Park Police on April 22. Earlier this week, SMU Police added additional car and bike patrols at night throughout the campus to provide extra security.
