SMU AWARE

AGGRAVATED ROBBERY AT CVS PARK CITIES PLAZA

On June 24, 2016, at approximately 4 a.m., an employee of CVS Pharmacy at 3012 Mockingbird Lane reported an aggravated robbery to University Park Police. Two suspects entered the CVS with a gun and took money from a cash register. No customers were in the store at the time.

One suspect is described as a black female with short black hair in her mid to late 20s, about 5 feet, 5 inches tall to 5 feet, 7 inches tall and weighing 180 to 200 pounds. She was wearing dark clothing. The second suspect is described as a black male in his mid to late 20s, about 5 feet, 9 inches tall to 6 feet tall and weighing 150 to 170 pounds. He was wearing light-colored shorts and a light-colored hooded sweatshirt.

The male suspect was driving a newer-model red Dodge pickup with chrome rims and exited eastbound on Mockingbird toward Central Expressway.

This incident is being investigated by University Park Police.
