
Why is understanding of Accounting and Finance a necessary skill?

To ascend in an organization, you need to understand the financial language. Financials are a scorecard of your decisions.



Objective of this program

Pedagogy

- Concepts will be illustrated with examples of how to apply them to real-world situations via
 - Examples, mini-cases and full length cases
- Cases will involve 3 to 4 key decision points and will necessarily involve judgement
 - Cases will likely not have the right answers and you may not have full information
 - Research shows that such an approach leads to greater retention
 - Develops analytical, communication and leadership skills


