



Based on the information provided by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), the Department of Homeland Security and/or the Social Security Administration did not have enough information to confirm your citizenship status. Below is a list of citizenship classifications along with the acceptable form documentation for each classification. Refugee status granted	I-94 form with endorsement C or D
Asylum status granted	I-94 form with endorsement E
Parolee	I-94 form with endorsement F

Endorsement Requirements

A	"Processed for I-551. Temporary Evidence of Lawful Admission for Permanent Residence. Valid Until (date). Employment Authorized."
B	"Temporary Form I-551. Admission for Permanent Resident at (port) on (date) verified. (Office of issuance) (date) (signature of issuing officer) (title)"
C	"Admitted as a Refugee Pursuant to Section 207 of the Act. If you depart the United States, you will need prior permission to return. Employment Authorized."
D	"Status changed to refugee pursuant to Section 207(c)(2) of the Immigration Nationality Act, on (date). Employment Authorized."
E	"Asylum status granted pursuant to Section 208, DHS Valid to (date). Employment Authorized."
F	"(Applicant) 'paroled' for an 'indefinite' period for 'humanitarian' reasons."

Forms I-668A, I-181, and I-181A are not acceptable forms as documentation of eligible non-citizen status.

NOTE: All non-citizens whose citizenship status is not automatically confirmed through the FAFSA database match between the U.S. Department of Education and the USCIS will be required to submit documentation of status to the Office of Financial Aid. Once documents are received and verified, a secondary confirmation (G-845 form) will be sent to the Dept. of Homeland Security to confirm eligibility. **DOCUMENTATION MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE OFFICE OF FINANCIAL AID IN PERSON IN ORDER TO VERIFY AUTHENTICITY. FAXED COPIES ARE PERMITTED IN ORDER TO ALLOW PROCESSING TO PROCEED TEMPORARILY. HOWEVER, PER FEDERAL REGULATION, YOUR FINANCIAL AID CANNOT DISBURSE UNLESS YOUR DOCUMENTS ARE VERIFIED IN PERSON.** Please contact your Financial Aid Advisor with any questions.
