


Take Advantage of How Adults Learn

Goal: Information Transfer




Transfer improved by

- Specific mention of what was learned
- Use the information
 - Examples of increasing complexity
 - "Quiz Effect"
- Motivation



Teaching Strategies 1:

A more informative Syllabus



Teaching Strategies 2:

- START EACH CLASS WITH:
- 1. CONTEXT: BRIEF REMINDER OF CLASS BEFORE
- 2. OVERVIEW OF THIS CLASS



Teaching Strategies 3: ENGAGE! (Make it Active)

- 1. Think/Pair/ Share
- 2. You work problems
- Students work problems/ report out




Teaching Strategies 4: ENTRANCE & EXIT "TICKETS"




Teaching Strategy 5: **MOTIVATE!** Show/tell students why this matters in practice
