

Automation Technology Steering Committee (ATSC)

Charge:

1. Participate in strategic planning for the libraries on automation and shared technology issues.
2. Focus on facilitation and coordination, with lesser emphasis on direction.
3. Provide a forum to resolve issues arising from the library management systems and other library-related information technologies.
4. Identify and charge task forces or working groups to make recommendations regarding specific issues.

Frequency of Meetings:

Monthly – Other meetings scheduled as necessary, depending upon the nature and urgency of issues to be considered.

Selection of Committee Members / Term Committee Members Serve:

The SMU Libraries' Collaborative Council (under the direction of the Dean of Libraries) and in consultation with the CIO from OIT (Office of Information Technology) for the OIT representatives, will appoint the members of ATSC and will decide upon the length of service of their appointees.
