The Department of Computer Science in the Lyle School of Engineering at Southern Methodist University invites applications for a full-time lecturer position. We welcome candidates from all backgrounds. This lecturer will be expected to teach undergraduate courses in Computer Science consistent with the individual's background, advise and mentor undergraduate students, and interact with student organizations.

Minimum Qualifications: The successful candidate must hold at least a Master of Science degree in Computer Science or a closely related field by the time of appointment.

Preferred Qualifications: A PhD in Computer Science or a closely related field is preferred. Candidates should be able to provide evidence of successful undergraduate teaching. Salary is commensurate with degree level and experience.

The position begins August 1, 2019.

The committee will begin its review of the applications on or about May 1, 2019. To ensure full consideration for the position, the application must be postmarked on or before May 2, 2019, but the committee will continue to accept applications until the position is filled. The committee will notify applicants of its employment decision after the position is filled. Hiring is contingent upon the satisfactory completion of a background check.
