SCHOLARSHIPS

The Lyle School envisions a new type of engineer, armed with the passion to confront big issues and the skills to solve complex problems. Establishing a Lyle Engineering Scholarship offers donors the opportunity to create a named fund and support these promising new leaders. The Lyle Engineering Scholars Program will provide merit-based scholarships of \$5,000 annually for four years to Lyle School students who have achieved superior academic success. Scholarships will be offered to students who meet rigorous admission standards and have earned both high grades and high SAT scores.

GIVING OPTIONS

ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP

\$20,000

An annual, named Lyle Engineering Scholarship may be funded with a contribution of \$5,000 each year for four years.

ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

\$100,000 MINIMUM

Donors may fund an endowed scholarship with a gift or pledge to be paid over a period of up to five years. To initiate this scholarship immediately, donors may choose to contribute an additional gift of \$5,000 annually for four years.
