APPLICATION PROCESS

Complete the graduate application located at https://gradadmission.smu.edu/apply/.

Pay the application fee of \$75 (cannot be waived).

Request official transcripts from any and all colleges and universities attended or from which you have received a grade.

Submit GRE test scores if you are applying to one of the following programs: Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Computer Science, Computer Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Security Engineering (if you do not have a minimum of two years industry experience), or Software Engineering (if you do not have a minimum of two years' experience in software development and/or maintenance).

The GRE or the GMAT is required for admission into the Engineering Entrepreneurship program, as well as the dual degree program, M.S. Engineering + MBA. Submit optional letters of recommendation to gradappmaterials@smu.edu.

Additional Requirements for International Applicants

TOEFL/IELTS results required unless English is your native language or you have completed a degree from an American university.

Certificate of Finance is required for all international applicants if admitted. Not required at the time of application.

Photocopy of the first page of your passport is required if admitted. Not required at the time of application.
