

### APPLICATION INFORMATION MASTER OF MUSIC IN MUSIC EDUCATION

### SMU offers two routes to a Master of Music in Music Education degree:

### 1. For candidates who already hold teaching certification:

#### Admissions requirements:

- 1. Completed bachelor's degree in music (B.M.), with a music GPA of at least 3.0 (on a 4-point scale)
- 2. At least two years of public school music teaching experience (or its equivalent)

# The following items should be included with your SMU & Meadows application:

- 1. Transcript showing completion of your bachelor's degree
- 2. CV or resume detailing teaching and education experience
- 3. Typed writing sample of at least 2 pages (e.g., Statement of Purpose or recent research paper from your undergraduate work)
- 4. Video clip (approx. 20 minutes) representing your teaching in a normal classroom setting or rehearsal. A brief (2-3 sentence) description of video contents/context is also helpful (i.e., grade level being taught, goal of lesson on video clip, or any other relevant details about the class you'd like us to know).
- 5. Three letters of recommendation
- 6. In addition, please contact Dr. Sarah Allen at *sarahallen@smu.edu* to schedule an interview with the music education faculty. Note: This interview takes place in lieu of an audition for the MM in Music Education. Please have all application materials submitted before your interview.

### 2. For candidates seeking Texas EC-12 All-Level Teaching Certification:

#### Admissions requirements:

- 1. Completed bachelor's degree in music (B.M.), with a music GPA of at least 3.0 (on a 4-point scale)
- 2. Able to attend SMU as a full-time student

# The following items should be included with your SMU & Meadows application:

- 1. Transcript showing completion of your bachelor's degree
- 2. CV or resume detailing teaching and education experience
- 3. Typed writing sample of at least 2 pages (e.g., Statement of Purpose or recent research paper from your undergraduate work)
- 4. Video clip (approx. 20 minutes) representing your teaching in a normal classroom setting or rehearsal. A brief (2-3 sentence) description of video contents/context is also helpful (i.e., grade level being taught, goal of lesson on video clip, or any other relevant details about the class you'd like us to know).
- 5. Three letters of recommendation
