SAS and SAS JMP Installation January 2018

Overview

SMU has acquired a site license for SAS Foundation and SAS JMP Professional for all faculty, staff and students. The software is available for download on any personal Windows and Linux machines for academic use. It is not compatible with MAC OS.

Please note: Students and any Mac OS users of SAS Foundation also have access to SAS without installing the software on their local machine. Simply login to http://apps.smu.edu.

Getting Started (Windows computers)

Please follow all instructions very closely. Connect your computer to a power source as the installation can take up to several. Be sure to backup existing libraries or directories where your current SAS files are saved.

Installation of SAS Foundation on Campus (Personal Machines)

If migrating from a previous version of SAS Foundation, please see SAS Migration Documentation.

- 1. Download the SAS.bat file located here
- 2. Right click the file that you saved to your desktop and choose "Run as administrator". You may need to provide administrative credentials for your personal computer.
- A login box should appear. Enter SMU\smuid (insert your ID number) for the username and your SMU Password. You should then see the following message "The command completed successfully"
- 4. The installer should begin after a few minutes. A progress bar will appear once all preinstallation tasks have been completed. Please note that there may be a significant delay (up to several minutes) for each screen to appear.
- 5. Choose your preferred language for the setup process
- 6. Click **OK**
- 7. Select Install SAS Software
- 8. Click Next
- 9. Click **Next** to accept the default SAS Home directory location
- 10. Select Install SAS Foundation and Related Software
- 11. Click Next, leave all other options as the default
- 12. Click Next
- 13. Click Next again
- 14. Select Clear All
- 15. Click Next
- 16. Click **Next** for Regional settings
- 17. Click **Next** to continue with the SAS Foundation installation



- 18. Click **Next** to being the systems requirements portion of the installation
- 19. Click **Start** to begin the installation. This installation may take up to an hour to complete, depending on the network connection. If you are off campus, please expect a greater delay.
- 20. Click Next at the completion screen
- 21. Click **Finish** to complete the installation
