**Full Time Equivalency**

FTE based on 12 students = 137.25

FTE based on 9 credit hours = 183

NOTE: Southern Methodist University calculates FTE for Perkins based on 12 credit hours. The Association for Theological Schools calculates FTE by dividing the total number of credit hours required for each degree by the number of semesters required to complete the degree; then that number is used to divide the total number of credit hours enrolled. Within Perkins students are considered full-time if they carry a minimum of 9 credit hours, thus allowing a FTE calculation based on 9 credit hours. FTE does not include the GPRS program.
