The Association for Theological Schools calculates FTE by dividing the total number of credit hours required for each degree by the number of semesters required to complete the degree; then that number is used to divide the total number of credit hours enrolled. Within Perkins students are considered full-time if they carry a minimum of 9 credit hours. FTE does not include the GPRS program.
