## **ORDERING YOUR NEW Spring 2018 SMU PARKING PERMIT ONLINE NOW**



Once you are registered for Spring semester classes you may order your new parking permit valid for use from January 1<sup>st</sup> 2018 until August 1<sup>st</sup> 2018. To order your Spring 2018 SMU parking permit and register your vehicle, simply visit www.smu.edu/parkingservices



Enter your SMU ID and password and click on the "Get Permits" link.

- To aid in the vehicle registration process, be sure to have your license plate number and vehicle information including make, model, color, and year readily available.
- Next, complete each step following the instructions on each page carefully. On the Payment Information screen in the description of the permit selected there is a hyperlink entitled "print permit". This is your temporary permit. Please print this permit to place on the dash of your vehicle. This permit will work for 10 days in lieu of your permanent one until you receive the permit in the mail. Parking Center access is active on your ID card only when the decal permit is used.
- The temporary permit is valid in the red "All University Permit" (AUP) areas indicated on the campus
  parking map for ten days. Parking Center access is not active on your ID card until you receive your decal
  parking permit. Please follow instructions on the temporary permit until you receive your decal parking
  permit.

All students living in an SMU residence hall, SMU apartment or sorority/fraternity house must register their vehicle and purchase a permit or opt-out of an SMU parking permit if he/she does not have a vehicle at school. If no choice is made, residential student accounts will be charged the annual parking fee. Residents of a SMU Apt, fraternity or sorority should supply proof of residency before ordering as your resident status is not automatic in the system.

If you are a non-resident and must drive, you will need a SMU parking permit to park on campus. However, purchase of a permit does not guarantee a space, parking is first come first serve with a permit.

Alternatives to parking on campus include; DART, SMU Express and ZipCar, VBikes etc.

Students must purchase their SMU parking permits or opt-out of a parking permit online at <a href="https://www.smu.edu/parkingservices">www.smu.edu/parkingservices</a>. Permits are not available in the Parking and ID Card Services Office. All permit orders will be mailed to the address selected. Please allow 10 days for delivery.

The parking permit fees will be charged to your SMU student account and paid for on my.SMU.edu or at the Student Financial Services window first floor Blanton Bldg.
