# The Stoody-West Fellowship For graduate study in religion journalism

### Offered by United Methodist Communications

#### ANNUAL AWARD: \$6,000

The fellowship is offered in recognition of the professional excellence and inspired service of the Rev. Ralph Stoody and the Rev. Arthur West, leaders in public relations and information services in The United Methodist Church.

**CRITERIA:** Must be a United Methodist who intends to pursue a career in religion journalism and enrolled inpost-graduate study at a school in the United States. (The term "religion journalism" in du des news writing for secular and church media and for church institutions. The committee will consider appropriate news and journalism forms, including electronic and broadcast media, as well as print.)

**APPLICANTS:** One fell owship will be awarded to the best United Methodist candidate.

**PURPOSE:** To enhance the recipients' professional competence and thereby help to perpetuate the standards exemplified by Ralph Stoody and Arthur West.

The Fellowship will be awarded each year to the best overall candidate.

The Stoody-West Fellowship Committee will meet around the first of April to review all completed applications and to make the selections for the award.

Finalists may be called by the committee for a brief telephone interview. The winner will be notified by telephone soon after the selection has been made. All other applicants will receive written notice of the decision of the committee.

#### **APPLICANTS ARE JUDGED ON FIVE CRITERIA:**

- Christian commitment and involvement in the life of the United Methodist
   Church
- Academic achievement as revealed by transcripts, grade point averages and the required letters of reference
- Journalistic experience and/or evidence of journalistic talent
- Clarity of purpose in plans and goals for the future
- Potential professional ability as a religion journalist

#### WHEN IS PAYMENT SENT?

One half of the \$6,000 award will be paid after the recipient provides proof of enrollment in a graduate program in an accredited school or department of journalism in the United States. The remainder of the grant will be paid after the recipient provides proof of enrollment for the spring term. The grant will not be paid for summer sessions.

Please submit one original and **five copies** of all materials (only one original is necessary for transcripts and letters of recommendation).

#### Provide all the following supporting materials:

**1) EVIDENCE OF YOUR APPLICATION TO OR ACCEPTANCE BY** an accredited and approved graduate school or department in the United States. (The recipient must show evidence of full-time enrollment before the award can be given.)

#### 2) THREE LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION ARE REQUIRED:

- (a) from your local church pastor or a denominational official
- (b) from the chairperson of the department in which you are majored as an undergraduate
- (c) an employer or supervisor for whom you have worked as a journalist.

If any of these is not available, a letter from a person related to journalism and personally acquainted with you may be substituted. Letters of recommendation should be sent by the writer directly to the scholarship Committee.

- **3) REQUEST YOUR OFFICIAL GRADE TRANSCRIPTS** from all institutions of higher learning you have atten ded. Transcripts should be mailed by the school directly to the address above. Submit your requests early, as schools are frequently slow about responding to requests for transcripts.
- **4) SEND A STATEMENT OF NOT MORE THAN 500 WORDS** about your interest in religion journalism and your planned course of study.
- **5) Submit No More Than 3 Examples of Your Journalistic Work** (audiovisual, electronic, print). If you request it in writing, these materials will be returned to you after the committee has completed its work.
- **6) SEND A RECENT PHOTOGRAPH OF YOURSELF** (either digital or print), prefera bly head and shoulders, suitable for publicity use if you are awarded the fellowship.

## The Stoody-West Fellowship for Graduate Study of Religion Journalism is given in recognition of the following persons:

#### REVEREND RALPH W. STOODY

The Rev. Dr. Ralph W. Stoody was the first general secretary of the Commission on Public Relations and Methodist Information of The Methodist Church. Dr. Stoody served in that position from 1940-64.

Educated at Ohio Wesleyan, Columbia and Harvard Universities, Boston UniversitySchool of Theology and what is now Garrett-Evangdical Theological Seminary, he was a pastor, journalist, war correspondent, author, speaker, and magician. His charisma earned the remark by a colleague, "You put the sparkle into Christianity." Dr. Stoody was indeed the master of the magic of words. Dr. Stoody died in 1979.

#### **REVEREND ARTHUR WEST**

The Rev. Dr. Arthur West was a pastor, author, communicator and pioneer in religion journalism. He served 27 years in communications within The United Methodist Church. His last appointment before retirement in 1975 was as head of the Division of Public Media with United Methodist Communications.

Dr. West was educated at Missouri Wesleyan College and Baker University. He holds degrees from Boston University School of Theology and studied journalism at Northwestern University. He served terms as religion editor of the Providence (R.I.) Journal and Bulletin and the Bangor (ME) Daily News. He currently resides in Lebanon, Ohio, with his spouse, Vera.

One of Dr. West's "truisms": "People have the right to know what is going on in their church. Our function is to report the news objectively whether we agree with it or not."
