

## **North Texas Conference Clergywomen Candidate Scholarship**

**Purpose:** To provide at least one \$1000 scholarship for women who are North Texas Conference candidates. The scholarships are for seminary and/or childcare expenses of the candidate.

**Eligibility:** Women applying must be certified candidates in the North Texas Conference. The candidate must either be enrolled in seminary or have completed seminary and be working in a church setting with a less than full time appointment. Those who are in the residency program or ordained are not eligible. Local pastors with a less than full-time appointment may be eligible.

**Application:** Applicants must submit their resume and the designated application by October 24, 2016.

**Selection:** The selection team will consist of convener of the North Texas Conference Clergywomen and other clergywomen leadership. The selection committee will be reviewed and elected by the North Texas Conference Clergywomen every two years.

**Process of Selection:** The selection team will review the applications and have interviews as needed.

**Funds:** Funds will be raised by the North Texas Clergywomen for this scholarship. The funds will be housed by the North Texas Conference and distributed after selection has taken place. The number of scholarships given will be determined by the amount raised.
